Information & Frequently Asked Questions

Where do I park?

There is convenient parking at the Stadium and a free shuttle from the lot will drop you off right by the House Office Building. To get to the Stadium take Rt 50 to exit 24, Rowe Blvd, take a right on Taylor Avenue, and parking lot entrances will be on your right.

Should I bring anything?

You will need a picture ID to get into the building. MCA will have materials for you to hand out to legislators.

What will happen when we get there?

We'll gather at 9:30am, legislators have been invited to drop by. At 10:00am, when the legislators go to the floors of the House and Senate, we'll have a "how to lobby" presentation and talk about the legislation MCA is supporting. Then small groups will travel to legislators offices to give them information about child abuse and MCA, and to ask for their support.

Which legislators will I see?
