Community Outreach Volunteer Position Description

The mission of Baltimore Child Abuse Center (BCAC) is to provide victims of child sexual abuse, trauma, and other Adverse Childhood Experiences in Baltimore and their non-offending caretakers with comprehensive forensic interviews, medical treatment, and mental health treatment with a goal of preventing future trauma.

Position Title: Community Outreach Volunteer

Position Summary: The Community Outreach Volunteer will represent BCAC at events including fundraisers, health fairs, and other outreach events. This volunteer will share the mission of BCAC with the community by engaging event participants in conversation, answering questions, handing out information about BCAC, and collecting contact information.

Responsibilities & Duties:

- Set up and break down outreach table;
- Hand out information to event participants;
- Engage event participants (have the sign an e-mail sign up list, talk about BCAC, share information about the event, etc.).

Required:

- Must have an outgoing personality;
- Must support BCAC and be passionate about the mission;
- Must complete training from BCAC staff;

Additional:

- Must be 16 or older or accompanied by an adult, and 21 or older for events where alcohol is served;
- Must have own means of transportation;
- Must be able to carry up to 25 lbs.
